European Elections - School Closure

Durham County Council have confirmed that they will require use of the school hall as a polling station for the European Elections on 23rd May. School will, therefore, be closed on 23rd May as we will be unable to safely open the school. We do not take the decision to close he school lightly. We have requested that the Council seeks alternative polling venues, but this has not been possible. As the owners of the school building, the Council have the right to request the use of the school premises. Safeguarding is our first priority. The school hall is to be used for voting and we have no way of safely opening the building in a way that can separate pupils and the voting public. The decision to close is therefore the only available option.
