Primary PE and Sports Premium Action Plan

<u>2018-19</u>

Department for Education Vision for the Primary PE and Sport Premium

ALL pupils leaving primary school should be physically literate and with the knowledge, skills and motivation necessary to equip them for a healthy, active lifestyle and lifelong participation in physical activity and sport.

The premium must be used to fund additional and sustainable improvements to the provision of PE and sport to encourage the development of healthy, active lifestyles.

It is expected that schools will see an improvement against the following 5 key indicators:

- 1. The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity the Chief Medical Officer guidelines recommend that all children and young people aged 5 to 18 engage in at least 60 minutes of physical activity a day, of which 30 minutes should be in school.
- 2. The profile of PE and sport being raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement.
- 3. Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport.
- 4. Broader experience of a range of sport and activities offered to all pupils.
- 5. Increased participation in competitive sport.

In 2018-19, Shincliffe CE Primary School will receive a PE and Sports Premium Grant of £17,790. A large proportion of our grant, £8,475 (47.6%), has been allocated for the Platinum SLA with Durham & Chester-Le-Street SSP. The Action Plan below demonstrates how we aim to spend this year's allocation in relation to the DfE's Primary PE and Sport Premium Key Indicators.

Taking part in the 36-hour fitness and health programme. This will be delivered by SSP staff in the Summer term (2019). It provides sports-related activities for students who are not engaged with physical activity or extra-curricular sport. It provides all students, regardless of ability, with the opportunity to be physically active.

As part of the Platinum SLA – Cost = £8475.

Has been running throughout the Summer '19 term for Year 3 and Year 4 classes. We also have a thriving afterschool club attended by 26 children. Additionally, these children attended a Change4Life Festival in June '19 giving the opportunity to increase activity through participation and competition.

Develop our outdoor learning space to offer OAA which can be used during curriculum time as well as for extracurricular activities.

Approximately £4000 budgeted for.

Meeting organised with OASES in October '17 to develop plans and explore further funding opportunities.

Following a Government announcement in late October '18, this plan was cancelled as the conditions of **Sports Premium** expenditure were revised to exclude capital funding projects. However, we were successful with securing a £5000 grant to fund a Trim trail which will be installed in summer '19.
