Young Writer Competition – "Connections," (can be fiction or non-fiction work). Children will be required to enter one A4 page, or up to 500 words about this theme. Completed entries should be returned to the school office no later than Tuesday 17th December 2019.

Young Photographer Competition – "Through my Eyes," children will be required to enter three photographs. The reverse of each photograph requires a brief sentence describing what the photograph represents in relation to the theme. Completed entries should be returned to school no later than Friday 31st January 2020.
