Please use 'COVID-19 TEST RESULT' in the subject line of your email. Staff continue to monitor emails and will respond as soon as they are able during non-working hours. I am grateful to all staff who are supporting me in working early mornings, evenings and weekends in order to support test and trace.

We will be shortlisting for the Deputy Headteacher post on Monday and interviews will take place next Friday. I will keep you updated as this process progresses further.
