What have we been learning?

- This week we have been learning the sounds **ck**, **e**, **u** and **r**. We have had a lovely time looking at many things that have these sounds in, either at the beginning, in the middle or at the end of the words. We each got a house point when we learnt **u** (and coloured in pictures of umbrellas), we tasted cra**ck**ers for ck, **r**aisins for **r** and we tried **e**lderflower juice when we learnt **e**.
- ♦ We have been learning a story and a song about "Thelma Three" and learning how to write the number 3 correctly, practising on the big whiteboard, using the rhyme "Over one hand, over the next, stop and think, which choice is best" to help us.
- On Monday morning we went on an Autumn Walk around the school grounds, looking for signs that Autumn has arrived. We collected some Autumnal objects too & (along with the ones that people had kindly sent in from home) we used these to create some beautiful Autumn transient art on Tuesday.
- We have been learning all about our sense of **sight** this week and talking about our favourite things to see as part of our Circle Time session.
