What have we been learning?

- We have been reading the story of "The Paperbag Princess" this week & we have enjoyed experiencing lots of princess and dragon related activities writing speech bubbles to show what the characters from the story might have said and also using collage materials to decorate our own paper dresses so that Princess Elizabeth (The Paperbag Princess) would have something nice to wear again!
- In our Phonics sessions this week we have been continuing to read and write words which contain four sounds independently; this time using words which contain simple consonant digraphs (e.g. mun<u>ch</u>, smash, bring, dress).
- In Maths this week we have been working out how much change we would have from 10p if we bought items which cost different amounts of money. We have also watched the first episode of the "Tia Ten Show" on Ten Town. This episode will be unlocked for your child if they'd like to watch it again with you this weekend.
