Primary PE and Sports Premium Action Plan

Department for Education Vision for the Primary PE and Sport Premium

ALL pupils leaving primary school should be physically literate and with the knowledge, skills and motivation necessary to equip them for a healthy, active lifestyle and lifelong participation in physical activity and sport.

The premium must be used to fund additional and sustainable improvements to the provision of PE and sport to encourage the development of healthy, active lifestyles.

It is expected that schools will see an improvement against the following 5 key indicators:

1. Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport.
2. The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity - the Chief Medical Officer guidelines recommend that all children and young people aged 5 to 18 engage in at least 60 minutes of physical activity a day, of which 30 minutes should be in school.
3. The profile of PE and sport being raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement.
4. Broader experience of a range of sport and activities offered to all pupils.
5. Increased participation in competitive sport.

In 2023-24, Shincliffe CE Primary School will receive a PE and Sports Premium Grant of £17,680 A large proportion of our grant, £9,000 (50.9%), has been allocated for the Platinum SLA with Durham & Chester-Le-Street SSP. The Action Plan below demonstrates how we aim to spend this year's allocation in relation to the DfE's Primary PE and Sport Premium Key Indicators. It is a working document and it is updated throughout the year. It will be updated online each term to show the progress being made.
