What have we been learning?

- This week has been our Little Wandle assessment week (due to the last half-term being such a short one!), so we have been recapping all of our tricky words, digraphs and trigraphs in our phonics sessions.
- In Maths this week we have been learning how to group objects fairly into sets of 2s, 5s and 10s. We have also learned how to form number **16** on "Ten Town" too.
- In our Understanding the World sessions this week, we have learned that the word "palaeontologist" describes a scientist who studies dinosaurs. We were really interested in looking at pictures of dinosaur footprints on rocks, dinosaur eggs and dinosaur bones, both in museums and when they were still buried in the ground.
