- ♦ This week we have started to learn about our senses and this week we have focused on **hearing**. We have been on a "Sound Walk" around our school; listening for and identifying the sounds that we could hear around our school building. We loved being "sound detectives"!
- ♦ In Maths, we have been counting forwards up to & backwards from 10 to 0. We have also learned all about **Zero Pond** during our first visit to Ten Town.

If you say the rhyme as your child is writing the number, it really helps with their number formation.
