## What have we been learning?

- This week we have been learning the sounds **h**, **b**, **f** and **l**. We have had a lovely time looking at many things that have these sounds in, either at the beginning, in the middle or at the end of the words. We tasted some lovely things too; **H**aribo sweets (vegetarian strawberry ones), **b**readsticks, lemonade and mini chocolate **F**ingers. We have been trying really hard with reading and writing words that contain these sounds too!
- We have been learning all about the 3ness of 3. We have looked at different groups of 3 objects & the different ways that 3 can be represented. We have also been using the words large and small (& also larger/largest & smaller/smallest) as we have been ordering Autumn objects practically from the smallest to the largest we have been busy!
- In our Understanding the World sessions we have been learning all about our **teeth** talking about how to look after our teeth to keep them healthy, sequencing pictures together to show how we brush our teeth & learning about why some of us might be starting to get wobbly teeth at the moment.
