What have we been learning?

- ◆ This week we have been recapping all of the sounds that we have learned during our Phonics sessions this half-term. We will start learning some more graphemes (sounds) as soon as we come back after the holidays.
- ◆ In Maths we have been listening to a story about “**Freddie 4**” and learning how to write the number 4 correctly. We have also been thinking about the words heavy and light. We have been holding two objects in our hands and deciding which one is heavy and which one is light. Then we tested our predictions using the bucket scales.
- ◆ We have also been recapping everything that we have been learning during our “**I am Special**” theme for this half-term. Our teachers were very impressed because we have remembered so much!

Homework

Literacy

- Continue to practise recognising the sight words in the clear packets - *a new set has been sent home today.*
- Recap on all of our sounds in the purple Sound Book. Please can you use this to recap on all of the sounds which we have taught during this half-term. *Can your child identify the sounds in their sound book? Can they think of any words that contain those sounds?*

Maths

- Practise forming **Freddie 4** in the yellow “Between Us” book & on the “Ten Town” website.
- Find pairs of objects around the house. Ask your child to use their hands to compare the weight of these objects & encourage them to use the language of weight to talk about them - **heavy, light, heaviest, lightest, lighter than, heavier than.**
