- ◆ In Maths this week we have been looking again at adding by counting on. We have solved simple addition calculations by showing our answers on number fans (using with numbers up to 10).
- ◆ In our Understanding the World sessions we have been sorting different dinosaurs depending on what they ate. We now know the fancy words “**carnivore**” and “**herbivore**” and we can explain what they both mean too!
